Pigalle

Champagne *Veuve Clicquot*

Brut R1 800

Powerful and complex, the Brut Yellow ensures continuity of the House style.

Rich R2 100

This champagne is lightly sweet, with fresh citrus and floral notes and a silky finish.

Brut Rosé R2 400

Elegant and fruity, this wine frees the sense, charms the eye and ravishes the palate.

Moët & Chandon

Brut Imperial R1 800

Subtle suggestion of flowers, vanilla, grapefruit, yeast, light and a mildmouth feel. Flavours show fruit, slight sweetness, toast, bread dough and yeast.

Brut Imperial 'Grande Vintage' R2 500

Paradoxically concentrated yet creamy, it is energetic and warm in the mouth, focusing on the fruit and then gradually taking on more profoundly bass notes.

Nectar Imperial R2 100

A rich, lively demi-sec expression of the Moët & Chandon style. Delicious flavours of pineapple and passion fruit with a rich, crisp finish.

Dom Perignon

Brut Vintage R5 900

Made only in exceptional years, Dom Perignon Vintage is produced exclusively from the noble grape varieties Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, selected from the best crus in Champagne.

Rosé Vintage R9 900

Coppery pink with soft glints of orange. The initial floral notes rapidly lead into glazed fruit, cherries and the zest of citrus fruit. The final notes consist of smoky accents and cocoa.

Methode Cap Classique *Pongracz*

Brut - Stellenbosch R390

The characteristic fine aroma is followed by an explosion of pinpoint bubbles; the yeastiness on the nose is complimented by rich complexity, finesse and a lingering aftertaste.

Rosé - Stellenbosch R410

This exciting Brut Rosé enthralls with a wonderful foamy mouthful of black berry fruit flavours and delicate yeasty tones that linger long on the palate.

Graham Beck

Brut - Robertson R430

Rich, creamy and lively as always, with biscuit aromas derived from the Chardonnay and richness owing to the Pinot Noir, all of which contribute to the firm palate.

"Bliss" Demi-Sec - Robertson R430

Light aromas of butterscotch, honey and praline. This delectable bubbly will stimulate your sweeter senses.

Sauvignon Blanc

Durbanville Hills - Durbanville R180

Delightful combination of ripe green fig, starfruit, citrus, green apple, winter melon, grass and minerality.

Thelema - Stellenbosch R260

Lovely fresh melon and grapefruit flavours, with a grassy palate, all in perfect balance.

Springfield 'Life from Stone' - Robertson R290

This single vineyard originated from the rockiest soil on the estate, with resultant struggling vines and huge concentration. Brilliant greenish in appearance, this is a dramatic wine full of ripe red peppers and passion fruit.

Klein Constantia - Constantia R350

Pungent aromas of guavas, citrus blossom and passion fruit greet the nose. The palate is poised on a knife edge of brisk mineral notes and succulent acidity.

Iona - Elgin Valley R390

Over the nose high floral notes of honeysuckle, lemon zest and ruby grapefruit over-lay Iona's distinctive herbal undertones. The palate is keenly balanced showing cut green apples and lime marmelade followed by great minerality and length.

Diemersdal '8 Rows' - Durbanville R540

An intense with concentrated aromas on the nose that follows through on the palate. The wine shows a strong core of minerality with a flinty elegance on the nose with a rounded mouth-feel and balanced acidity on the finish. A seamless wine where all the components are in perfect balance.

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Chardonnay

- Diemersdal Unwooded - Durbanville R200**
Concentrated spicy aromas of fruit fruity flavours.
- De Wetshof 'Finesse' - Robertson R320**
The soils limestone and clay components help the vines to have a strong citrus flavour with apronounced nuttiness and leads to clean zesty finish with citrus notes.
- Glen Carlou - Paarl R400**
Intense aroma with a bouquet of lime-tree blossomes, gooseberry, peach and citrus. A clean finish with well-integrated oak in the end.
- Vergelegen - Stellenbosch R490**
The wine shows an attractive lemony yellow-green colour with a complex nose of citrus, white peach, apricot, tropical fruit and mineral tones. The palate is long and full with delicate wooding. Beautifully refined and elegant.
- Rupert & Rothschild Baroness Nadine - Franschhoek R690**
Crisp lemon notes with subtle grapefruit nuances and smooth creamy nougat flavours, followed by lingering macadamia nut undertones.
- Iona - Elgin Valley R730**
The wine shows concentrated marzipan and citrus notes, with underlying hazelnut and lime notes, which adds to layered complexity. The wine is seamless, with flavoursome and long finish.
- Creation Reserve – Coastal R890**
Single Vineyard, vibrant grapefruit and apple, with hints of honey and cinnamon and gentle oak.

White Blends

- Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc - Coastal R200**
This full bodied Sauvignon Blanc based blend offers a variation of fruit characters including ripe gooseberry, green peppers, green melon and hints of tropical fruit.
- Haute Cabrière - Franschhoek R280**
50% Chardonnay and 50% Pinot Nor. This versatile blend is extremely limited and hugely popular with a soft blush of pink; the Chardonnay give elegance and the Pinot Noir richness.

Chenin Blanc

- Cederberg – Olifants River R210**
This crisp, reductively made Chenin Blanc is in true Cederberg style, showing a powerful nose of tropical melon, grapefruit and lemon peel. Five months of lees contact created a mouth tingling crispness with a lingering finish.
- Durbanville Hills Collectors Reserve – Durbanville R330**
Elegant wine with lime and sweet apricots. Oak spice and vanilla, finishes with a creamy texture.
- Ken Forrester Old Vine Reserve - Stellenbosch R390**
Golden hued and full bodied, with melon and spicy baked apple aromas. Layered, with mineral notes enhanced by honeycomb and caramel flavours.
- Rijks - Tulbagh R490**
Goldish tint. Pineapple and apricot aromas on the nose underlined with whiffs of almonds. Well-rounded palate with great wood integration ensures a palate full of pleasures. Long lasting with a creamy aftertaste.
- Radford Dale 'Renaissance' - Stellenbosch R780**
Aged in Burgundy barrels and hand-picked from a single block of bush-vine. Crisp and fresh with aromas fo quince and apple. A beautiful Chenin Blanc with a full and long finish.
- Ken Forrester The FMC - Stellenbosch R1 350**
Rich and sophisticated, awarded South Africa's best Chenin Blanc three times. Layers of apricot, ginger, honey and vanilla creme brulee. Held together with gentle oak and a fresh finish.

Rosé & Blanc de Noir

- Allesverloren Tinta Rosé - Swartland R190**
Fresh raspberries and cherries on the palate with a hint of vanilla. Exhibiting a perfect sugar / acid balance, it has a delicious lingering aftertaste.
- Spider Pig Bro/Zay Rosé - Western Cape R230**
Delicious Rosé for bromance or romance. Candyfloss and strawberry ice cream flavours.

Cabernet Sauvignon

- Tokara - Stellenbosch R350**
A brilliant dark plum colour. Aromas of dark cherries, casses and ripe plums. An elegant finish of red berries and mint.
- De Wetshof Naissance - Robertson R430**
Full-bodied and sumptuous with brooding dark berry fruit intensity layered with oak spice nuances supported by soft ripe tannins and a smooth fruity finish.
- Thelema - Stellenbosch R640**
Complex and stylish, with ripe blackcurrant and blackberry flavours with a hint of mint and subtle oak.
- Rust & Vrede Estate - Stellenbosch R950**
Deep ruby. Bold creme de cassis, cigarbox and liquorice are subtly supported by notes of bkackcurrant and dark chocolate. A great example of a Rust end Vrede Cabernet Sauvignon, approachable, opulent wine is full of velvety tannins with a refined, elegant yet bold finish.

Shiraz

- Saronsberg Provenance - Tulbagh R290**
The soft textured tannins, full-bodied mouthfeel and silken finish lends itself as a platform to heady mix of red berry and black fruit flavours.
- Tamboerskloof - Stellenbosch R510**
Intense dark red berry flavours, followed by hints of chocolate, pepper, spice and florals. Full and rich with elegant tannins.
- Saronsberg Estate - Tulbagh R620**
Succulent ripe Fruit flavours are supported with scents of violets and delicate spices. Finely crafted tannin and intergrated oak Flavours.
- Kevin Arnold - Stellenbosch R690**
Could this be the best Shiraz in the country! Benchmark cape-rhone style red from the master of this varietal packed with all the rich spicy fruit and smoky cigarbox and farmyard whiffs which hint at staunch wood bakcing without every being overpowering.

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Pinotage

- Ken Forrester Petit - Stellenbosch** R200
Spicy mulberries, cherries, juicy and accessible with delicious fruit concentration.
- Lanzerac - Stellenbosch** R440
This Pinotage possesses an excellent deep colour, with ripe berries and plums on the nose and palate with a good mouth-feel and lingering aftertaste.
- Diemersfontein 'Carpé Diem' - Wellington** R490
It is praised for its easy accessibility, its uniqueness, its wonderful rich coffee, smoky overtones on the nose – and yet the preservation of voluptuous fruit on the palate, along with spicy, cinnamon and chocolate notes on the palate.
- Rijks - Tulbagh** R550
Banana leaf, cherry and red berry aromas are supported by whiffs of vanilla. These aromas carry through on a full-bodied spicy palate with rounded tannins.

Merlot

- Durbanville Hills - Durbanville** R210
A medium-bodied wine with hints of red fruit, rounded off with silky tannins and a full mouth-feel.
- Jordan - Stellenbosch** R430
Mature vineyard yields opulent fruit with plum, rich blackberry and mocha flavours. Framed by generously rounded tannins and spiciness from maturation in French oak.
- Hartenberg - Stellenbosch** R490
Silky and elegant with long lasting flavour. Expect black and red fruits, vanilla and orchards of plum.
- Meerlust - Stellenbosch** R960
Deep, youthful purple colour with a ruby rim. Intense dark brambly fruit on the nose, mulberry, liquorice and damson plum with hints of dark chocolate and spice, tempered by a stony minerality.

Pinot Noir

- Haute Cabrière - Franschhoek** R490
Made from Burgundian clones firm and richly dense with signature cherry nose.
- Hamilton Russel - Hemel & Aarde Valley** R1 090
This Pinot Noir is not overly fruity, soft and sweet. It generally shows hints of primal character, with a dark, spicy and complex fruit perfume.

Red Blends

- Rupert & Rothschild 'Classique' - Franschhoek** R450
Inviting cranberry and raspberry aromas with an earthy, mineral focus and a lingering cinnamon and walnut finish.
- Vergelegen 'DNA' - Stellenbosch** R630
Compote of berry fruit, nicely rounded by chocolate and coffee notes. The tannins are round and soft with a lingering finish.
- De Toren 'Fusion V' - Stellenbosch** R1 150
Meticulously crafted from Bordeaux's 'Noble Five' varieties and, with its complex flavours of liquorice, black cherry, cedar and dark berries, it offers a stylish departure for sophisticated oenophilic tastes. Soft as spun silk, with a lingering hint of sweet fruit on the back palate.
- Meerlust Rubicon - Stellenbosch** R1 100
Very classic Rubicon nose with violets, ripe plum, cedar wood and intense spiciness. A typical liquorice note and stony minerality also evident on the nose. Still youthful and intense, promising further maturation potential. The palate is full-bodied, structured by beautifully sleek, ripe tannins which restrain the vibrant dark fruit typical of this vintage. The wine lingers on the palate with creamy fruit mouth-filing linear tannins.
- Rupert & Rothschild 'Baron Edmond' - Franschhoek** R1 350
A sophisticated blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot hand-picked from select vineyards. Matured in new French oak, this unique wine releases elegant blackberry flavours strapped in layers of cigarbox aromas with delicate coriander undertones.

| A light and delicious dessert wine with characters of honey blossom, citrus and creme brulee on the nose, and flavours of apricot and honey on the palate. | | |

| 5 Star John Platter, 91 points in Wine Spectator. This Noble Late Harvest has sumptuous peach and apricot flavours, overlaid with a tropical lushness of melon and pineapple. A ripe sweetness and tanginess, with sweet and sour zip. | | |
| Klein Constantia 'Vin de Constance' - Constantia | R160 | R1 950 |
| Drunk by Napoleon on his deathbed, enjoyed by Royalty and regarded as one of the world's most iconic wines. Burnished copper in colour, with abundant aromas of dried mangoes, apricots and honey. The palate is unctuously full-bodied and intensely flavoured, with a thick, viscous consistency pared by pithy astringency and a fresh, mouth-watering finish. | | |

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
